Course Registration

All students register for classes at SMU via a bidding system called BOSS (Bidding Online System). Students will be given e\$100 dollars (one-time only), which they will use to bid for all their desired courses. This empowers them to draw up their own timetable based on personal choices and study plan, subject to constraints of curriculum requirements, and the supply and demand of classes. It is important for students to familiarise themselves with the information, policies and procedures which will be provided after they complete their application, so that they do not find themselves in an unnecessary bind. Course registration for exchange students will take place in late July.

The course offerings for AY2019/20, Term 1 will be available in early July.

At the moment, students may refer to the <u>online SMU course catalogue</u> which is for reference ONLY.

Restricted Courses

All exchange students are only allowed to enrol for undergraduate courses (course codes 001-499). Exchange students are required to select their courses from a prescribed list which will be made available in early July, as not all undergraduate courses are available to exchange students.

As per our exchange agreement, your nominated students will only be allowed to enrol in courses offered by SMU School of Social Science.

Scholarships

The following scholarships are available for students to apply:

Temasek Foundation LEaRN Scholarship (S\$6,500)

- · Full-time undergraduates of Asian nationalities
- · Completed 1 year of studies at home university at the time of scholarship application
- Good academic performance (minimum cumulative GPA of 2.70/4.0) and proficiency in English
- Willingness to live in another culture, in local conditions
- · Ability to take on an ambassadorial role required of an exchange student
- · Mandatory enrolment of course OBHR001 Leadership and Team-building

- 8 awards available for incoming students in Fall 2019. All applicants will be placed in a common pool for selection.
- Exchange students will be invited to apply in April and successful applicant(s) will be informed in June.
